WHEN I PULLED THE OLD CASING OUT THERE WAS ONLY 18' OF GALVENIZED PIPE IN IT AND WHEN I CLEANED THE WELL OUT THERE WAS ABOUT 16' OF SAND AND SHALE IN THE BOTTOM SO \*\*GLEANED-THE-IT WAS DECIDED THAT IT WOULD BE BEST TO PUT THE NEW CASING DOWN BELOW THE SAND STONE AS THERE IS ABOUT 8' OF SHALE RIGHT UNDER THE SAND.

THERE IS NO BARN OR HOUSE ON THE FARM. JUST A SMALL MACHINE SHED ABOUT 150' FROM THE WELL. NO TOILET. SEPTIC TANK OR TILE FIELD.

THE HORSE CORAL IS ABOUT 50' BELOW THE WELL.
