Reference is made to the construction for the well of Rod Satter, that you recently submitted. We thank you for the report, but are returning it to you for additional information.

In Item 1, kindly enter the name of the county in which the well is located. In Item 2, kindly report the quarter section in which the well is located.

In Item 7, you report you constructed a 10-inch diameter drillhole from the surface to the 253 foot depth and a 6 inch diameter drillhole from the 253 foot depth to the 550 depth. In Item 10, you state you had no way of knowing what formations were penetrated by the drillhole from the surface to the 550 foot depth. On the reversed side of the report you state that the old galvanized casing had been removed and that a new casing was installed to a point below the sandstone formation. Apparently you reamed out the old drillhole to a 10-inch diameter which extended to the 253 foot depth. It is doubtful that this operation could be undertaken without your having some knowledge of the formations penetrated. Certainly you must know the nature of the soil that exists above the top of the rock formation, the approximate depth to the top of the rock and also the various types of rock that the 10-inch diameter drillhole penetrated to the 253-foot depth. Kindly enter all available information under Item 10 of this report.

It is noted that this well is reported to supply water for horses only. However, quite frequently this office is requested to approve this type of well to supply water for human consumption or the preparation of food products. Therefore, it is essential that all available information be entered on the construction report.
